- Experience in childcare is welcome but is not a necessity.
- Minimum level of B2 English language (no formal certificate required)
- Newly qualified graduates are welcome

Responsibilities of position:

- You will provide a high quality, caring, safe and stimulating learning environment that enables children to develop at their own pace.
- You will be responsible for planning and delivering stimulating, exciting and balanced programmes for learning in accordance with the relevant curriculum documents for Early Years in Scotland.
- You will be committed to providing the best possible outcomes for our children and families and will fully embrace the organisation's values and guiding principles, supporting all of our children and families to secure the best possible start in life and reach their maximum potential.
- As a member of the Early years' workforce in Glasgow, you will have a solutions-focused outlook, excellent communications skills and a passion for ongoing learning and professional development.
- The successful candidate will be required to be a member of the Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) Scheme and will be required to be eligible to register with the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC).
- Successful candidates will be required to commit to a minimum of 6 months in order to be eligible for the re-location package on offer.
- You will be part of a **GROUP OF SPANISH RECRUITS**, who will be supported through an intensive Induction to Scotland, Glasgow, Early Years in Scotland and the organisation and role itself.
